3 White is for **purity** / freedom / completeness.

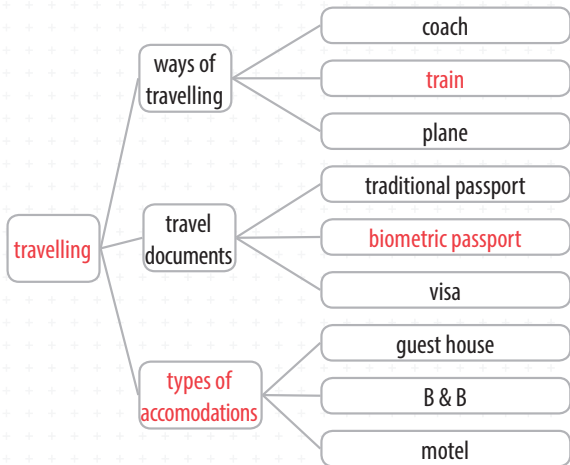
4 Blue is for hope / ocean / **loyalty**.
